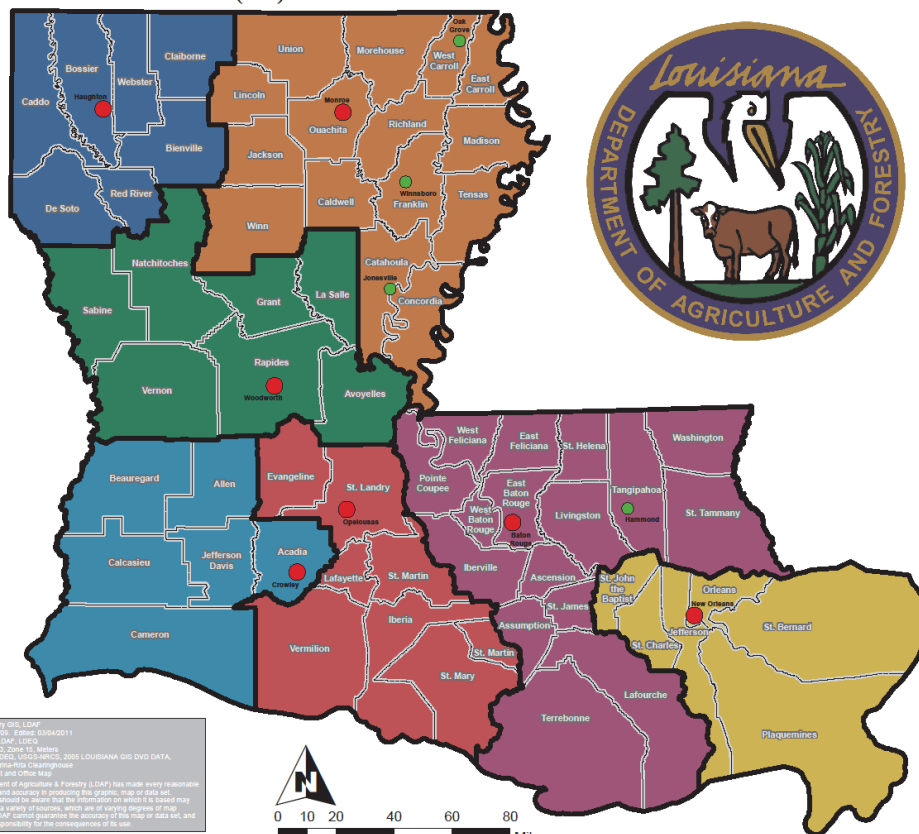
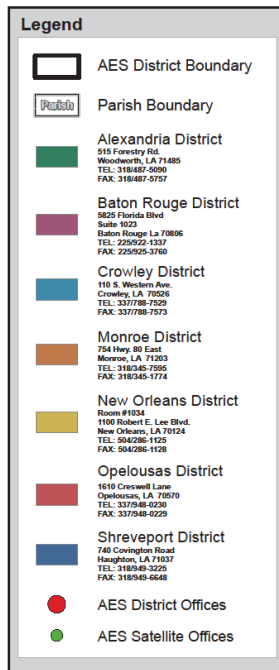

# Laws, Statutes, Rules, Regulations and Procedures

- **Law** = Louisiana Revised **Statue**; a law passed by the state legislature. RS 3:3201- 3:3396 is the Louisiana Pesticide Law <http://www.legis.la.gov/Legis/Home.aspx>
- **Rules & Regulations** = Part of the Louisiana Administrative Code passed by commissions. These are published in the Louisiana Register. Title 7 Agriculture and Animals. <http://www.doa.la.gov/Pages/osr/reg/register.aspx>
- **Procedures** = Written and unwritten Department and office **policies** for the flow of paperwork.

These Laws are the highest level of regulations and grant authority to various Commissions to create Rules/Regulations. These laws can only be modified by the legislature. **Title 3** (Agriculture & Forestry) contains the laws LDAF is charged with enforcing.

# Some Examples of Pesticide Statutes

## §3242. Certification of commercial applicators

A. No person shall apply or supervise the application of any restricted use pesticide as a commercial applicator unless that person has the proper certification.

Certification shall be issued only after the applicant has satisfactorily passed an examination. The commissioner shall establish categories and subcategories for certification in different areas of commercial application and shall establish specific standards for each category and subcategory.

Certification shall be **valid for three years** and shall be renewed in accordance with rules adopted by the commissioner.

The commissioner by rule shall provide for **the issuance of annual certification cards**.

Commercial applicators may supervise the ground application of restricted use pesticides within the commercial applicator's certification by competent uncertified individuals who are under the direct supervision of the commercial applicator. Commercial applicators shall not supervise the aerial application of any pesticide by any uncertified person.

# Some Examples of Pesticide Statutes

## **§3243 Licensing of owner-operators**

A. No person shall own or operate a business engaged in the application of pesticides for a fee unless that person has the proper license. Licenses shall be valid for one year and shall be renewed in accordance with rules adopted by the commissioner. There shall be three classes of licenses:

- (1) Ground applicators
- (2) Aerial applicators who do not apply phenoxy herbicides
- (3) Aerial applicators who apply phenoxy herbicides

B. All aerial applicators employed by the owner-operator shall be commercial applicators. All ground applicators employed by the owner-operator shall be commercial applicators or shall work under the direct supervision of a commercial applicator.

# Some Examples of Pesticide Statutes

## §3248 **Direct supervision**

Persons who hold certificates issued under the provisions of this Chapter may provide direct supervision for the application or sale of a restricted use pesticide by competent uncertified persons.

The certified person shall be **fully responsible** for the actions of the uncertified persons under his direct supervision.


The certified person shall give instruction and direction to the uncertified persons and shall be available when and if his presence is needed.

The certified person need not be physically present at all times unless the commissioner by rule requires the physical presence of the certified person at the time the restricted use pesticide is sold or applied.

##### Chapter 1. Authority, Pesticide Declarations, Definitions

###### §101. Authority

A. Under the authority of the Louisiana Pesticide Law, R.S. 3:3201 et seq., and in accordance with the provisions in R.S. 49:950 et seq., the commissioner of Agriculture and Forestry adopts the following regulations.

B. The commissioner of Agriculture and Forestry, in accordance with R.S. 3:3203(E) has determined that pharmaceuticals administered to livestock used for agriculture purposes are pesticides. Pharmaceuticals administered to livestock used for agricultural purposes shall be registered with the department in accordance with the Louisiana Pesticide Law and the rules and regulations found in this Chapter.

b. Post-application activities include those such as: restricted-entry intervals; responsibilities related to worker training, notification, and decontamination; providing emergency assistance; transporting or storing the pesticides; and disposing of any excess pesticides, spray mix, equipment wash waters, pesticide containers, and other materials containing the pesticide.

*Bulk Facilities*—any person, except registrants, who engage in the activity of repackaging any agricultural pesticide product, except manufacturing use products and plant-incorporated protectants into refillable and non-refillable containers. This includes certified commercial applicators and licensed owner-operators dispensing agricultural pesticides from a stationary container.

*Containment Pad*—a containment structure that meets the design, construction materials and capacity requirements of 750 gallons or 100 percent of the capacity of the largest

**§711. Certification of Commercial Applicators**

- B. Categories are established on the basis of the location where the application of pesticides will be made, and each applicant for certification is required to successfully complete an examination in the category in which the applicant desires certification.

...

**Ornamental and Turf Pest Control (category 3). This category includes commercial applicators using or supervising the use of restricted use pesticides to control pests in the maintenance and production of ornamental trees, shrubs, flowers, and turf.**

§711 g. aerial applicators shall successfully complete the aerial application of pesticides examination.

*Drones (UAVs) that are used in pest control must be controlled by a pilot certified by the FAA and LDAF (category-11 aerial applicator).*

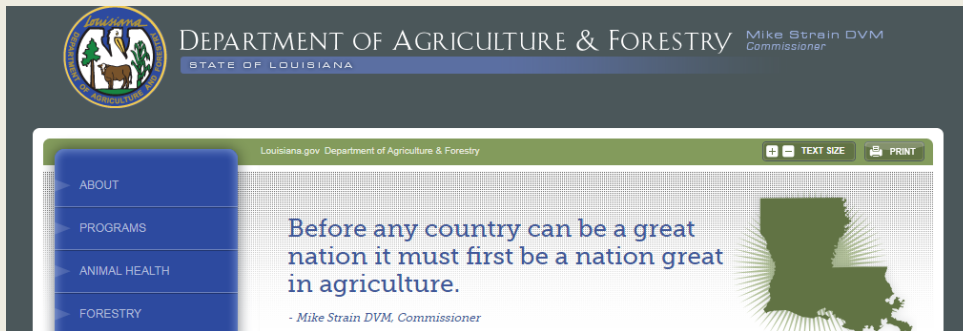

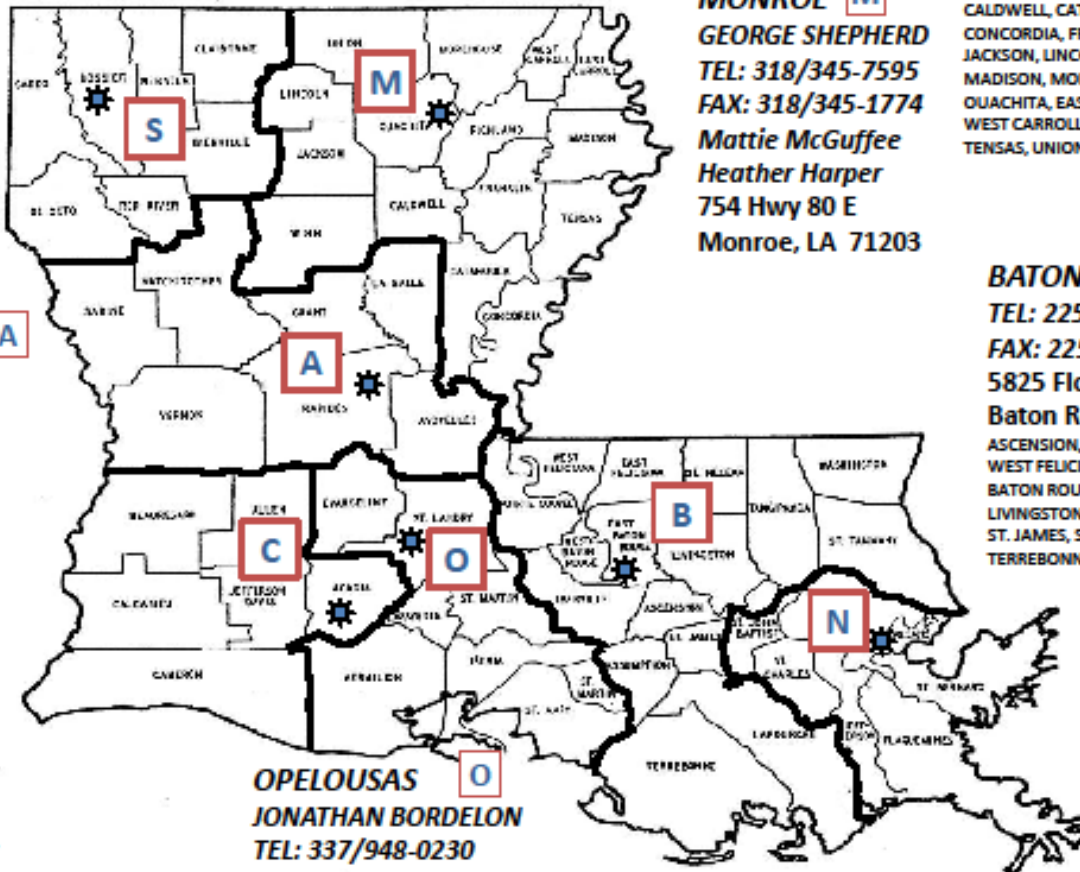

\*\* Applicants applying to take the Subcategory 8d exam must have earned a Bachelor's Degree with at least 12 hours in Entomology and must include official college transcripts, or must have attained at least four years of experience working in an established mosquito control program and must include a notarized affidavit of the work experience.

\*\*\* Applicants may take Demonstration and Research exams in Categories 1 through 5. Applicants must also check an additional exam, for example, 1 and 10. These count as two exams.

\*\*\*\* Applicants applying for the Category 11 exam must also check an additional exam; for example, 11 and 1. These count as two exams. In addition, applicants must also view a drift minimization video upon successful completion of the exams.
